Responding to questions of clarification from Councillor McCluskey, Mr. Mitch Dickey, HRM Planner, clarified that there is no definition of "compatible" in the MPS. Mr. Kurt Pyle, Supervisor, Planning Applications, also clarified that "compatible" is a broad term generally relating to compatibility in terms of bulk and mass. The decision ultimately rests with Council whether they feel that the proposal is compatible with the surrounding context.
