(ii) North West Transit Advisory Committee

North West Community Council Councillors entered into discussion regarding the North West Transit Advisory Committee (NWTAC). The following highlights were noted:

- the NWTAC's Terms of Reference was last amended in April 2006
- there should be equal representation from each of NWCC's five Districts
- all NWTAC membership terms are valid until November 2010

MOVED BY Deputy Mayor Johns, seconded by Councillor Outhit, that North West Committee Council increase the membership of the North West Transit Advisory Committee to include the portions of Districts 2 and 23 incorporated into the North West Community Council and appoint one (1) member from each of these

Districts to the North West Transit Advisory Committee.

During the ensuing discussion, it was noted that once the NWTAC membership terms have expired, North West Community Council would reexamine the NWTAC Terms of Reference with the intent to decrease the size of representation from Districts 19, 20 and 21 to two Committee members from each District. It was further noted that Districts 2 and 23 would remain with representation of one Committee member from each of those Districts.

(i) Amendment to North West Community Council - Rules of Procedure

MOVED BY Councillor Outhit, seconded by Councillor Dalrymple, that North West Community Council amend Section 1(a) of the Rules of Procedure to reflect the revised area of the Community Council and replace existing 1(a) with:

"Community Council" means the North West Community Council consisting of the members of Halifax Regional Council elected in polling Districts 19, Upper Sackville-Beaver Bank, polling district 20, Lower Sackville, and polling district 21, together with that portion of districts 2 and 23 that are within the Beaver Bank, Hammonds Plains, Upper Sackville Municipal Planning Strategy.

(iii) North West Planning Advisory Committee

North West Community Council Councillors entered into discussion regarding the North West Planning Advisory Committee (NWPAC). The following highlights were noted:

- NWPAC membership terms have been extended to November 2010
- the Terms of Reference provide that certain members terms are valid until January 31, 2011, March 10, 2011 and March 31, 2011
- Districts 2 and 23 should have at least one member
- a suggestion was made that Councillors Dalrymple and Lund have the option to attend a NWPAC meeting as non-voting members

MOVED BY Deputy Mayor Johns, seconded by Councillor Outhit, that North West Committee Council increase the membership of the North West Planning Advisory Committee to include the portions of Districts 2 and 23 incorporated into the North West Community Council and appoint one (1) member from each of these Districts to the North West Planning Advisory Committee.
