9.3.1 Sackville Kinsmen Splash Pad Committee re: Splash Pad Project

A copy of the Splash Pad Committee's presentation, along with background information on the Kinsmen Park (Sackville) Splash Pad was before the Community Council.

Mr. Jeff Ainslie and Mr. Alan MacKinnon, of the Sackville Kinsmen Splash Pad Committee, delivered a presentation respecting the Kinsmen Park Splash Pad Project to the Community Council. Mr. Ainslie and Mr. MacKinnon responded to questions.

A brief discussion ensued with Councillor Dalrymple indicating that he would be willing to provide funding from his capital funds in 2012.

In response to a question from Councillor Johns, Mr. Ainslie indicated that the total estimated cost of the project was \$450,000. Mr. Ainslie noted that the Kinsmen were hoping to reduce the cost with in kind donations. He further indicated that they would be seeking municipal and Provincial funding and fundraising to fund the project.

MOVED by Councillor Dalrymple, seconded by Councillor Johns that North West Community Council advise staff that the NWCC fully supports the Splash Pad Project being proposed by the Sackville Kinsmen and requesting that staff identify 1/3 of the total required funding in the 2012/2013 budget. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.
