REPORT

Governor of City Prison.

CITY PRISON, Halifax, May 2, 1892.

The Chairman and Members of City Prison Committee:—

GENTLEMEN,—

I have the honor to submit, for the information of the City Council and the public, my report on the operations of the City Prison for the twelve months ending 30th April, 1892.

From the attention given by the chairman and members of the committee to the affairs of the prison, you have become so familiar with its management, that there is not much to report on, if anything, that will be new; and I can only express the hope that you have found matters to your satisfaction.

I am pleased at being able to state that the conduct of the prisoners as a whole during the year has been better than in any other year since I have been in charge of the prison. Lacking the excitement to turbulence which they unfortunately have had in some former years, they have been generally quiet and obedient, and I am convinced that with some, at least, the lesson learned from their imprisonment has not been without good effect.

Though not given to praising people for doing what is simply their duty, I feel that in this place a reference to the careful and conscientious manner in which the several keepers have performed their duties during the past year should be made, and I have much pleasure in saying that

in these respects they have given every satisfaction. While treating the prisoners fairly, they have exacted compliance with the prison regulations, and thus not only have not given cause for discontent, but have not set bad examples to others.

I have to report an unusual amount of sickness the past year the prison having come in for a full share of the grippe epidemic, not confined to the prisoners, but affecting every officer and employe of the place. The City Medical Officer, at all times prompt and kind in his attendance, was particularly so during this very trying period, to officials and prisoners alike, and by his constant watchfulness and care, not only averted more serious consequences. but I am surs made the prisoners feel that, though only prisoners, they were, when sick, to be treated kindly and made to feel as little as possible the unpleasantness of their position.

I feel I would not be doing my duty—even though I repeat what I have said many times before—if I did not again direct your attention to the urgent need there is for an increased supply of water for the prison, for domestic purposes, and of course for fire purposes, too. At present, so far as fire is concerned, should such an event unfortunately happen, the city's valuable property is entirely without protection; while for domestic purposes the supply is entirely inadequate, and only those who suffer can tell how painfully true this is. As I have pointed out before, the time lost in bringing water to the prison by men and carts is considerable, as the labor thus diverted from its legitimate uses might be productive of better financial results for the institution—a consideration which should have weight with the City Council, apart from the safety of the city property and the health and comfort of those who live within the prison grounds.

The absence of any means of escape other than doors in case of fire, should also be brought to your notice, with the hope that the matter will receive the attention which its importance demands. This question, as well as that of water, is one which ought to be understood by the whole City Council, as it is well understood by the committees which have from time to time had the oversight of the prison; and therefore I

feel I need not apologize for pressing these matters on your attention, with the hope that the City Council may take the necessary action.

Of the Superintendent Poors' Asylum.

HALIFAX POORS' ASYLUM,

30TH APRIL, 1892.

To the Chairman and Members of the Charities Committee.

GENTLEMEN:—I hereby submit for the information of His Worship the Mayor and the City Council the sixth Annual Report of the Halifax Poors' Asylum.

At the beginning of the year there were 289 inmates in the Institution, 152 men, 124 women, and 13 children.

The largest number in the House at one time during the year was 328 on Feb. 28th., and the smallest number was 259 on the 21st September.

There were 336 persons admitted during the year, 38 births in the Institution and 45 died.

There were 542 persons supported during the whole or part of the year.

The inmates have been employed as usual at the general house work, and making and repairing shoes and clothing for the Institution.

The Institution has also earned \$1468.76 in making concrete for the City Board of Works.

Enclosed is the name, age, religion, birthplace and number of days of each inmate from 1st May, 1891, to 30th April, 1892.
