Chapter 77 of the Acts of 1912, the Board of Control Act, brought into force April 2nd, 1913 by proclamation of the Governor-in-Council, retired all the then members of the City Council from April 30th, 1913 and provided for the election biennially of four Controllers by the whole electorate of the City and of twelve Aldermen, two from each of the Wards, by the electors of each Ward.
