Halifax July 11th 1846

At a Special Meeting of the City Council held this day Present, His Worship the Mayor, Aldermen Poyer, Jennings, Kemmear, Fairbanks, and Winters. Messrs. Cleary, Richardson, Thomson, Sinclair, Black, Hunt, Clarke, Pulling and Rugg.

Read over Proceedings of 23rd June.

The City Council were summoned to take into consideration an application of Commissioner of Ward Number 6 for Ten Pounds to obtain the Stone broken for Keupl Road - The Opinion of the Recorder relative to claim of William Gray Esquire to the Upper Fish Market - an application from the Water Company for part of the Common - a Report of Committee of City Property and the transaction of other business.

Read a Letter from Mr. Steele addressed to Mr. Rugg when the following Resolution is introduced:

"From the almost impassable state of the Keupl and Campbell roads in many places, and from the great deficiency of funds at the disposal of the Commissioner of Ward No 6.

Resolved, That the sum of Fifty Pounds be granted to said Commissioner out of the general fund, from which the sum of Ten Pounds shall be appropriated for obtaining the Broken Stone from Mr. Steele as intimated in his Letter, and that the amount shall be equally expended upon the Keupl and Campbell roads

to which the following amendment is introduced

Resolved, That the sum of Fifty Pounds be granted to Commissioner of Ward Number 6, to be expended in the Keupl and Campbell road, the said amount to be equally expended on said roads

which amendment being put is passed, the original Resolution is therefore lost.

Read the following Opinion of His Honor the Recorder relative to Mr. Gray's claim to Upper Fish Market:-

"Recorder's Office 28th June 1846.

My Dear Sir,

Mr. Jennings's letter to you of 19th ult. alleging in behalf of William Gray Esquire a claim to the upper Fish Market premises of this City; your answer that the same would be laid before the first Meeting of the Council for their consideration, together with the Resolution of the City Council referring the subject to me - I have just received and considered.

The Land upon which the Fish Market stands was granted to certain Trustees for the use of the Town - it is not to be presumed that the Government would without full power make such Grant. I conceive that the City has ample title

to the premises in Question and cannot therefore recommend any compromise or even negotiation on the subject. This I beg you to submit as my Opinion to the City Council.
