Read following Opinion of His Honor the Recorder

Recorder's Office

8th August 1848

Gentlemen, The question submitted to me on the legality of the Assessment Book for this year, as extracted from the Minutes of 3^d instant, is very indefinite; but I have reason to suppose that the object of the City Council is to ascertain whether the Assessment as returned is not too erroneous for them to act upon. If right in my supposition I would observe that the general rate defective as it may be in many respects, is in my opinion sufficient for the Council to proceed with in the usual way of hearing and determining Appeals. The duties of Council are defined by the 9th clause of the Act by which their authority is limited to the hearing of objections of persons or who may complain of being over-rated or over-assessed, and the power of the City Council in such cases is restricted to reducing or confirming the rate in each particular case. I would suggest, however, that if the amount should eventually prove to be largely deficient, it might be well to cause another Assessment to be made, so long as the whole of the Assessments for the year do not exceed the amount prescribed by the Act of Incorporation.
