Ms. Beverly Miller, acting as the Chair, called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm

3. <u>Case 01062: Halifax Peninsula LUB Amendments - Landscaped Open Space in the R-3 Zone (Randa Wheaton)</u>

A staff report dated February 04, 2008 on the above noted was before the Committee. Ms. Randa Wheaton, Senior Planner, Community Development - Planning Applications, advised the Committee that Case 01062 is an application by HRM to amend the Halifax Peninsula Land Use By-law R-3 Zone requirements for landscaped open space. She explained that a 'problem statement' was developed because there were issues that needed to be addressed. Ms. Wheaton reviewed the staff report and gave a presentation with the following points outlined:

Ms. Miller expressed concerns with the proposed amendments to the Halifax Peninsula Land Use By-Law. She advised that enforcement of rooftop requirements will be difficult. She stated that the proposed amendments are in direct opposition to the HRMbyDesign 10

Big Moves, as passing these amendments would decrease landscape open space on the ground.

Ms. Wheaton responded to questions of clarification from the Committee, after which the Committee discussed putting forward a motion to Peninsula Community Council.

MOVED by Mr. Gunn, seconded by Ms. Perrott, that the District 12 Planning Advisory Committee recommend that Peninsula Community Council:

- 1. Give First Reading to the proposed amendments to the Halifax Peninsula Land Use By-Law as provided in Attachment "A" of this report, and schedule a public hearing.
- 2. Approve the proposed amendments to the Halifax Peninsula Land Use By-Law as described in Attachment "A" of this report.
