### 5.3.1 Greater Halifax Partnership – Update on Economic Strategy

An Information Report dated October 6, 2011 was submitted.

Mr. Paul Kent, President and CEO, and Mr. Fred Morley, Executive Vice President and Chief Economist, Greater Halifax Partnership provided a presentation on the progress to date on the implementation of the Economic Strategy. (A copy of the Power Point Presentation was submitted for the official file).

Mr. Kent and Mr. Morley responded to guestions.

Councillor Lund noted that recently there was a report in the newspaper that housing permits issued last year were down but permits for apartment buildings were up. He suggested that this was contrary to the information in the presentation.

In response, Mr. Morley advised that in his view there were noticeable differences as to what happens in Halifax in the housing/apartment/condo mix, and condominium prices in Halifax are quite high compared to other jurisdictions. He suggested that this could be a result of decreased competition in the condominium market in Halifax and more emphasis on the apartments. Mr. Morley also suggested that there may be systemic issues involved. He advised that he wasn't sure if much research has been carried out in this regard, but he would follow up with HRM staff and see if they may have this information.

The Chair thanked Mr. Morley and Mr. Kent for the update.

- 7.1.1 Functional Plans with Environment and Sustainability Standing Committee Oversight
