A draft report dated December 13, 2013 entitled, 'Special Advisory Committee on Arts and Culture Report to HRM Staff' was submitted.

Subsequently, it was agreed that that the amount of 'Transfer from Community Grants' would be revised to \$95,109 (average last four fiscal years) from \$280,000, and the figure for 'Tax Exemption' (\$500,000) would have an asterisk noting that the actual figure is to be confirmed by HRM staff.
