- 9.1.1 Update on Non-Profit Tax Relief

The following was before the Committee:

• A staff information report dated February 29, 2016

Mr. Bruce Fisher, Manager, Financial Policy and Planning, briefly addressed the staff report, explaining that the current practise for providing tax relief to non-profit groups was developed at the time of amalgamation. Mr. Fisher noted that staff are working with the Province to make adjustments to the Halifax Charter that would make it easier to provide tax relief to charities and non-profit organizations. Mr.

Fisher also commented that staff are trying to shift the focus from percentage of tax relief to the actual amount of tax paid.

Mr. Fisher responded to questions of clarifications regarding the status of previous reports addressing tax relief reform and proposed changes to the Halifax Charter.
