- Enforcement: target enforcement based on data/evidence (location, time of year, days...) Due to time constrains the Committee was unable to re-group and report/deliberate their brainstorming sessions.

The Committee agreed to schedule an extra meeting for January 30, 2014 in order to have their action plan sent to the Transportation Standing Committee for its February meeting with a projection to be before Regional Council in March.

The Chair expressed the importance of time lines, budgets, and resources. He stated that there are costs associated with the plan that have to be addressed.

Discussion ensued around the Pedestrian Safety Campaign. The Committee requested that a copy of the "Distraction Kills Campaign" presentation be redistributed to them. The Committee discussed running ads, indicating that it should follow different times of the year. The Committee will take a closer look at this once they review the Campaign for recommendation.

The Chair suggested the Committee consider having a "Crosswalk Safety Day" and hold Town Hall meetings in the Fall.
