### 6.1 <u>Lands of Patrick Dupuis, Three Fathom Harbour Rd., Three Fathom</u> Harbour, NS

• A report prepared for Ms. Kelly Hunt, Co-ordinator, Support Services, dated 19 January, 2004, on the above noted, was before the committee.

Mr. Cameron Brown, By-Law Enforcement Officer, with the aid of a video, presented the staff report.

Mr. Dupuis addressed the Committee stating he would request the option to make repairs rather than demolition.

Councillor Hetherington noted that the building inspector has indicated that the building is no longer structurally sound.

Mr. Brown confirmed that the inspection was done after the hurricane.

Mr. Dupuis stated he would like to have a reasonable amount of time to demolish the building and noted he will take responsibility for the demolition of the building and clean up of the property.

MOVED by Councillor Sarto, seconded by Councillor Cooper, that the committee issue an Order requiring the demolition of two dilapidated structures, the removal of the debris and backfilling and crawl space, within thirty (30) days after service upon the owner/occupant. Otherwise, the Municipality will exercise its rights as set forth under Part XV of the Act Respecting Municipal Government. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

# 6.2 <u>Lands of Oceanwave Lobster Incorporated, 173 West Dover Road, West Dover, NS</u>

 A report prepared for Ms. Tanya Phillips, Manager, By-Law Services, Community Projects, EMS, dated April 14, 2004, on the above noted, was before the committee.

Mr. Bill MacGillivray, By-Law Enforcement Officer, with the aid of a video, presented the staff report.

MOVED by Councillor Blumenthal, seconded by Councillor Cooper, that the committee issue an Order requiring the demolition of the partially collapsed red fish storage facility and removal of all demolition debris within thirty (30) days after service upon the owner/occupant. Otherwise, the Municipality will exercise its rights as set forth under Part XV of the Municipal Government Act. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

# 6.3 <u>Lands of Gabriel Wortman, Paul Stanley Wortman, et al, 191 Portland</u> Street, Dartmouth

• A report prepared for Ms. Tanya Phillips, Manager, By-Law Services, Community Projects, EMS, dated April 15, 2004, on the above noted, was before the committee.

Mr. Dave Bradshaw, By-Law Enforcement Officer, with the aid of a video, presented the staff report advising the siding is being removed and the building is in the process of being demolished.

MOVED by Councillor Blumenthal, seconded by Councillor Cooper, that the committee issue an Order requiring the demolition of the fire damaged structure and the removal of all demolition debris within thirty (30) days after service upon the owner/occupant. Otherwise, the Municipality will exercise its rights as set forth under Part XV of the Municipal Government Act. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
