Mr. Don Shea, By-Law Enforcement Officer, with the aid of a video, presented the staff report.

 A staff report prepared for Andre Noël, Regional Coordinator By-Law Enforcement, Community Projects, dated June 9, 2004, on the above noted item, was before the Committee.

Mr. William MacGillivray, By-Law Enforcement Officer, with the aid of a video, presented the staff report.

Mr. Joseph Charbel Arab, the property owner, addressed the Committee and advised that he can provide a letter from an engineer confirming the steps are secure. He stated that he felt the deterioration of the property was not unsightly and indicated he would put cement in the gap in the steps.
