Councillor Cunningham advised a group of Dartmouth residents calling themselves the Coalition of Lakes were holding a press conference on Friday, February 6, 2004 requesting a moratorium on any development on Lake Banook.

Councillor Cooper submitted a petition from the residents of Lynwood Estates and requested staff contact the residents with regards to petitioning the streets in the subdivision for paving. Further, staff be advised there is a need for traffic lights a the intersection of Broom Road and Main Street as per the Mainstreet Development Plan.

Councillor Smith advised that a Wood Doctor is a furnace that is legal and only allowed to burn clean wood but are designed for use in rural areas and placed the following motion.
