- 10.2 Renaming of Pocket Park at the Corner of Queen and Alderney Drive to the Joe Howe Park and Approval of Application to Install Joe Howe Podium

Harbour East Community Council approve the application by the Downtown Dartmouth Business Commission, in conjunction with the Joe Howe Initiative, to provide financial assistance of up to \$5000, equal to 50% of the cost of the project, in keeping with the HRM Murals, Monuments and Markers Policy.

### 12.1 Case #00725: Amendment to Development Agreement - Eastern Passage

 A staff report dated September 28, 2004 prepared for Paul Dunphy, Director of Planning and Development Agreement, was before Community Council for consideration.

MOVED by Councillor McInroy, seconded by Councillor Warshick that Harbour East Community Council:

- 1. Amend Section 3.6 of the existing Development Agreement to extend the time line for the completion of the Agreement until September 18, 2004 with no public hearing being required.
- 2. Approve the Amending Agreement as shown in Attachment A to the September 28, 2004 staff report.
- 3. Require that the Amending Agreement be signed within 120 days or any extension thereof granted by Community Council on request of the applicant from the date of the motion approved by Community Council and any other bodies as necessary whichever approval is later, otherwise, this approval will be void and obligations arising hereunder shall be at an end.

# 12.2 <u>Correspondence - Alan Ruffman - Tulip Street between Beech and Maple Streets, Dartmouth</u>

# 12.3 <u>Administrative Order Governing Harbour East Community Council - Councillor Cunningham</u>

Councillor Cunningham referred to the reduction in the number of Districts within the Harbour East Community Council area and MOVED, seconded by Councillor Warshick that Legal

Services draft an amendment to the Administrative Order governing the Harbour East Community Council with respect to reducing the number of members from seven to six and changing the makeup of the Community Council to Districts 4 through 9, and further that this change to the Administrative Order be presented to Regional Council for ratification prior to the next scheduled meeting of Harbour East Community Council, November 18, 2004. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

### 12.4 Request for Four Way Stop - Councillor Smith

Councillor Smith referred to the safety concerns of residents of District 9 relative to the intersection of Robbie Burns Drive and Primrose Street. The Councillor indicated that residents of the area have been trying to have safety measures put in place at that intersection for a number of years.

MOVED by Councillor Smith, seconded by Councillor McInroy that staff provide a report regarding the installation of a three or four way stop at the intersection of Robbie Burns Drive and Primrose Street and further that staff look at measures to ensure safety when turning right off of Robbie Burns Drive onto Primrose Street as it is difficult to see oncoming traffic due to the location of a fence at the corner of Robbie Burns Drive. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
