10.1 <u>Case 00784 - Time Extension to Sign Development Agreement</u>

 A report dated December 12, 2006, on the above noted, was before Community Council.

MOVED by Councillor McInroy, seconded by Councillor McCluskey, that the Harbour East Community Council require the signing of the Twin Lakes Ltd. Development Agreement within 120 days following the land acquisition of the Bartlin Road right-of-way and portion of the Alderney School property as described in the December 12, 2006 report. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

10.2 <u>Case 00988 - Amendment to Russell Lake West Development</u>

A report dated December 20, 2006, on the above noted, was before Council.

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Mr. Paul Morgan, planner, presented the report to Council noting:

- The interchange was originally intended to be finished by October 2006,
- The province has advised they don't expect the interchange to be opened until June due to deficiencies;
- Clayton has an extension to coincide with the opening of the interchange.

In response to Councillor McCluskey, Mr. Morgan advised the work had been contracted out to Dexter Construction.

Councillor Younger expressed concern with the number of occupancy permits and how HRM is going to ensure that people will not move into the homes until the interchange is completed and suggested staff flag this issue.

MOVED by Councillor Karsten, seconded by Councillor Younger, that the Municipality enter into the amending agreement, presented as Attachment A to the December 20, 2006 report, which would:

- Grant Clayton Development Ltd. an extension from October 31, 2006 until December 31, 2006 to July 1, 2007 to complete all other required work associated with this road extension in accordance with the terms of the Russell Lake West development agreement provided that financial security for completion of the work is provided in a form and amount acceptable to the Development Officer;
- 2. Require the amending agreement be signed within 120 days or any extension thereof granted by Council on request of the applicant from the date of final approval by Council and any other bodies as necessary whichever approval is later, including applicable appeal periods, otherwise, this approval will be void and obligations arising hereunder shall be at an end.

Councillor Karsten noted there is no anticipation of completion until June or July of 2007. He noted that it is his understanding that where a mortgage company is involved an occupancy permit may be required as part of that process.

Councillor McInroy advised he was in support of the request by Clayton Developments.

At the request of Councillor Kent, Mr. Morgan advised staff would provide an information report outlining the deficiencies.

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MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

10.3 <u>Case 00734 - Development Agreement for 124 Albro Lake Road,</u> Dartmouth

A report dated December 14, 2006, on the above noted, was before Council.
