9.2.2 Dartmouth United Soccer

Ms. Maureen McIntyre and Mr. Jeff Powell addressed Community Council regarding soccer in Dartmouth suggesting the acquisition by HRM of the Shannon field and complex would benefit the sport in Dartmouth and surrounding areas.

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MOVED by Councillor Warshick, seconded by Councillor McInroy that the Harbour East Community request the CAO in conjunction with Parks and Recreation regarding provisions that can be made, such as setting up a reserve fund, in order to acquire this property when it becomes available. Further, that Development Services gather information on the Science Campus proposal and how it would fit in the overall development plans for HRM. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

- 10.1.1 <u>Councillor Cooper Streetscape Improvements Cole Harbour Road,</u> Forest Hills Parkway, Highway #7
- A report prepared for Mr. Paul Dunphy, Director of Planning and Development Services, dated December 21, 2001, on the above noted, was before Community Council.

Councillor Cooper noted that there is potential for further development in the area between the Parklow and Ross Road along the #7 Highway but streetscape improvements are needed to make the area more amenable for development. The Councillor noted that one aspect regarding the lack of development may be the availability of services along the #7 Highway, namely the extension of the sewer lines on the #7 Highway towards Ross Road area.

MOVED by Councillor Cooper, seconded by Councillor Warshick, that the Harbour East Community Council forward the report to Regional Council recommending that they further develop plans to address the needs as outlined in the report with the addition of considering the Main Street area towards the Parklow and the extension of sewer service along #7 Highway towards Ross Road.

The Councillor indicated the report mentioned the Lawlor's Point area which to date has not been addressed but needs to be given serious consideration.

Councillor McInroy expressed concern with the inclusion of the extension of sewer service along the #7 Highway suggesting the recommendation be separated into two separate recommendations.

Without a vote being taken on the motion, the following motion was placed.

MOVED by Councillor Cooper, seconded by Councillor Warshick, that the Harbour East Community Council request a staff report be provided on a sewer service extension along the #7 Highway towards Ross Road. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

MOVED by Councillor Cooper, seconded by Councillor Warshick, that the Harbour East Community Council recommend Halifax Regional Municipality develop plans to address the needs as outlined in the December 21, 2001 Information Report with the addition of consideration being given to the Main Street area from the Parklow to Ridgecrest Drive. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
