### 2.1 <u>Case 00501 - Rezoning Application - Martinique By The Sea Properties Ltd. -</u> <u>East Petpeswick Road, Middle Musquodoboit</u>

• A report prepared for Mr. Paul Dunphy, Director of Planning and Development Services, dated March 15, 2004, on the above noted, was before Community Council.

The staff report was recommending the following:

"Marine Drive, Valley and Canal Community Council refuse to approve the proposed rezoning of an approximate 2.5 acre (30m x 330m) corridor of land from R-6 (Rural Residential) to MU (Mixed Use) Zone to allow for the construction of a private road on lands described in the report based on the policies of the Municipal Planning Strategy and staff evaluation contained herein".
