Mr. Mike Young, Berkshire Developments, Musquodoboit Harbour, advised that the development would be on a private road which would be gated. There would be a condominium corporation which would collect fees to be used for road maintenance, snow removal, lawn care, etc.

On question from Councillor Streatch regarding emergency vehicle access, Mr. Young advised the gates would be keyed in such a way as to allow unrestricted access by emergency vehicles.
