- 4.1.1 Request for Crosswalk Intersection of St. Margaret's BayRoad and Timberlea Collector off Exit 3.- Councillor Rankin
- An Information Report dated November 1, 2006 was before the Community

# 4.1.2 Request for Crosswalk Repainting in front of Beechville Baptist Church, St. Margaret's Bay Road - Councillor Rankin

• A letter dated December 6, 2006 from the Honourable Minister Angus MacIsaac was before the Community Council.

The Honourable Minister MacIsaac advised that Terrence Bay Road has been submitted for paving by the Central District as a priority for capital paving. Pending budget approval, it is expected that the road will be paved in the 2007-2008 fiscal year. Sandy Cove Road recently received extensive patching and is not scheduled for repaving in 2007.
