2. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u> - August 27, 2007

MOVED by Councillor Meade, seconded by Councillor Rankin, that the minutes of August 27, 2007, as presented, be approved. MOTION PUT AND PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

3. CONSIDERATION OF DEFERRED BUSINESS

3.1 <u>Variance: File No. 13942, 1594 John Brackett Drive, Herring Cove</u>

Councillor Adams thanked Ms. Lindy Weilgart for bringing the matter of the watercourse setbacks to the Community Council's attention. He explained, with confirmation from Mr. Austin French, Manager, Planning Services, Community Development, that the error was due to the order in which amendments were put forward which caused a small portion in the village of Herring Cove to be negated in regard to watercourse setbacks and buffers. However, the oversight in the Regional Planning document does not have any bearing on the variance before Community Council as it is a separate issue.

Councillor Meade, upon receiving confirmation that the proposed building at 1594 John Brackett Drive would be 100' from the watercourse, placed the following motion: MOVED BY Councillor Meade, seconded by Councillor Rankin that the Western Region Community Council deny the appeal and uphold the Development Officer's decision to approve the variance. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

Councillor Adams advised that he will present the petition submitted by Ms. Lindy Weilgart in regard to the Herring Cove Services and Settlement Strategyat that evening's Regional Council session and will request the following amendment to the By-Laws:

Direct staff to pursue an appropriate amendment to the Cheb ucto Community Land Use By-Law to implement the Herring Cove Services and Settlement Strategy and Cheb ucto Peninsula Planning Strategy relative to watercourse properties and setb acks. He added that the amendment should take approximately two and a half weeks. He requested that Mr. Austin French, Manager, Planning Services, and Ms. Kelly Denty, Supervisor, Planning Applications, explain the process to amend the error to Ms. Weilgart upon adjournment of this meeting.
