- 10.1.1 <u>Case 01110: Amendment to Sign Requirements Planning District 1 & 3 (St. Margarets Bay) Land Use By-law</u>

### 10.2.1 Funds allocation: Waterstone Group - Councillor Meade

Councillor Meade advised that boundaries changes in October 2007 with Lucasville Road going to District 19; since the change approximately \$4000.00 per year included in the Hammonds Plains Area Rate.

MOVED BY Councillor Meade, seconded by Deputy Mayor Adams, that Western Region Community Council approve allocation of funds from the Hammonds Plains Common Area Rate in the amount of \$12,000.00 for the Waterstone Group for the Waterstone Playground. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

### 10.2.2 Funds allocation: Glen Arbour, Traffic Island Project - Councillor Meade

MOVED BY Councillor Meade, seconded by Deputy Mayor Adams, that Western Region Community Council approve allocation of funds from the Hammonds Plains Common Area Rate in the amount of \$13,000.00 for the rehabilitation of the garden bed at the traffic island on Glen Arbour Way, the Traffic Island Project. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

# 10.2.3 <u>Funds allocation: Cost of reproduction for area rate ballots: White Hills and Highland Park - Councillor Meade</u>

MOVED BY Councillor Meade, seconded by Deputy Mayor Adams, that Western Region Community Council approve allocation of funds from the Hammonds Plains Common Area Rate in the amount totalling \$2,159.43 - \$1,396.25 for White Hills, and \$763.18 for Highland Park for the cost of reproduction and mailing the area rate ballots conducted for Highland Park and White Hills. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

### 10.2.4 Chebucto Peninsula Wilderness - Councillor Rankin

Western Region Community Council endorsed the goal as initiated by the Chebucto Peninsula Wilderness Coalition at their meeting on April 28, 2008. A letter of support was sent to the Halifax area MLAs and Provincial Cabinet Ministers and Leaders of the Provincial parties following the April 28, 2008 meeting. Western Region Community Council are requesting Regional Council support on the initiatives of the Chebucto Peninsula Wilderness Coalition.

MOVED BY Councillor Rankin, seconded by Deputy Mayor Adams, that Western Region Community Council request Regional Council endorse the goal as initiated by the Chebucto Peninsula Wilderness Coalition, and reflected in their application to the Province to have those crown lands bounded by Highway 103 and 333 protected under the Wilderness Area Protection Act.
