1. <u>2002/2003 OPERATING AND CAPITAL BUDGET DELIBERATIONS</u>

1.1 <u>Financial Services</u>

Ms. Dale McLennan, Director of Financial Services, outlined the proposed Financial Services budget.

In response to Councillor Walker, Ms. McLennan advised False Alarm Ordinance revenues are split 40/40/20 between Fire, Police and Financial Services.

Councillor Cooper requested staff prepare an information report on what type of policy is in place regarding block funding.

1.2 Information Services

Mr. Chuck Keith, Director of Information Services, outlined the proposed Information Services budget.

MOVED by Councillor Goucher, seconded by Councillor Sloane, that an amount of \$150,000.00 be added to the Parking Lot for the Integrated Electronic Document Management program. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

In response to Councillor Warshick regarding the costing of upgrading the network in Council Chambers, Ms. McLennan advised that Council can add this to the budget. Ms. McLennan cautioned that a determination would have to be made as to what would come out of the budget if this is put in. The Councillor requested costing be provided by the end of budget deliberations for consideration.

1.3 <u>Human Resource Services</u>

Mr. Pat Hartling, Director of Human Resource Services, outlined the proposed Human Resource Services budget.

1.4 <u>Real Property Services</u>

Mr. Mike Labrecque, Director of Real Property Services, outlined the proposed Real Property Services budget.

MOVED by Councillor Warshick, seconded by Councillor Goucher, that \$100,000 be added to the Parking Lot for the Shubenacadie Municipal Campground electrical upgrades from the facilities upgrade on page A-10.

Mr. English, Deputy CAO, advised that this project, if it were to be funded, would be out of

Parks and Recreation, not Real Property Services.

No vote was taken on the motion.

Councillor Walker requested a listing of all the requests that came forward from the major HRM facilities.

MOVED by Councillor Johns, seconded by Councillor Harvey that \$500,000.00 be placed in the Parking Lot for the Beaver Bank Fire Hall. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

1.5 <u>Legal and Administrative Services</u>

Mr. Wayne Anstey, Director, Legal and Administrative Services, outlined the proposed Legal and Administrative Services budget.
