Motion for North West Community Council to Consider:									
That North West Community Council approve an allocation of \$23,725.00 from the Sackville Landfill Compensation Fund to the Friends of First Lake Society to assist with the completion of the First Lake South Side Trail Development									
Reason: This trail section, once linked with the existing 3.7 km of AT trail on the north and western borders of the lake, will complete the lake-side trail through the HRM-owned greenbelt and will link the community on Chandler and Johnston Drives to the Sackville High School and recreational facilities including the Sackville Sports Stadium, the Kinsmen Park, the Sackville Sports Arena and the Sackville Lakes Provincial Park. Halifax Regional Council adopted Healthy Communities as a Core Priority area. This project is a great example of active transportation, which was one of the key themes identified in Mayor's Conversation on a Healthy Livable Community.



Chair and Members of North West Community Council:

The Friends of First Lake Society would like to request funding in the amount of \$23,725 from the Sackville Landfill Community Compensation Fund for the following project. The project description and funding plan which follow are as presented in our application for funding to the Province's Connect2 program offered by the Department of Energy. The highlighted proposed contribution from the Sackville Landfill Community Compensation Fund was originally proposed as a contribution by the Lake District Recreation Association who have subsequently informed us that, given other capital priorities, they do not have sufficient funds available to support us this year. LDRA has provided funding support for our trail development activity in the past.

This application is for Phase 1 of 3 of the total project.

This project will essentially complete the First Lake Greenway trail system on the public lands bordering First Lake. The existing 3.7 km of trail were funded by HRM and the Province. The Province continues to support our initiative but we no longer have access to capital funding from the HRM AT trails program as this trail section is not considered a priority AT linkage. We will be applying to the recently announced federal Enabling Accessibility Fund (as well as to the Provincial programs) for the next phases of this project. The timing of that application will not permit funding of this year's activity.
