Re: Permissive Truck Signage Hammonds Plains Road

At the North West Community Council April 26, 2012 meeting, staff advised that permissive truck signage will be installed in appropriate locations, in relation to concerns raised by the community to the Community Council of trucks using non-routes in relation to By-law T-400. It was noted that this signage would be enforced by RCMP under the *Nova Scotia Registry of Motor Vehicles Act*.

During the public participation, the question was raised as to how this signage would deter trucks from using non-truck routes. Community Council is asking for monthly updates of the enforcement statistics (ie. number of tickets issued, warnings given) in relation to the permissive truck signage along Hammonds Plains Road.
