SUBJECT: Parking Concerns on Chelsea Lane

INFORMATION REPORT

<u>ORIGIN</u>

Item 9.2 raised at the April 8, 2014 meeting of the Halifax and West Community Council.

Councillor Walker submitted a petition signed by twelve residents requesting No Parking signs to be installed on Chelsea Lane, Halifax. He requested that the petition be forwarded to staff.

LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY

Part 1, Section 25, (e), (i) "Powers and Duties of Community Council" of HRM Charter.

BACKGROUND

Chelsea Lane is an 8.0 metres wide residential cul-de-sac off Willett Street in Clayton Park. There are currently no parking restrictions on the street.

DISCUSSION

Staff has assessed the roadway and concurs with the concern regarding parked vehicles impeding access. The roadway width of only 8.0 metres provides insufficient space to accommodate dual sided parking. A work order has been prepared to install a No Parking zone on the east side of the street between Civic #13 and the intersection of Willett Street.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

The installation of the No Parking sign will be accommodated within the 2014/15 Operating Budget.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Community engagement was not deemed to be necessary in this process because decisions were based on operational procedures.
