Councillor Lund advised that he had reviewed the file and had visited the site and sees no reason not to move forward. He requested that he, as the area Councillor, be kept apprised of all future matters pertaining to the development and that he have access to correspondence between HRM, the Developer and the Province.

Mr. Luc Ouellet advised that access to the requested material could not be guaranteed as the development permit process, through which a development agreement was implemented, was not open to public scrutiny, therefore; an application through Freedom of Information (FOIPOP) may be required.
