The report should include a review of practice in other jurisdictions, and address administrative, intergovernmental, legislative, and procedural implications. The scope of the report should include, but not be limited to: donation and spending limits, further disclosure of campaign spending, when money can be raised, and options, if any, for possible sanctions when rules are not followed.
