9.1 Staff

9.1.1 Workplan to Implement Auditor General's Recommendation in Review of the Concerts on the North Common

An Information Report from Mr. Richard Butts, CAO dated August 2, 2011 regarding the Auditor General's recommendations in review of the concerts on the Commons was before the Committee.

Mr. Butts advised the report outlined the progress to date noting that an internal project team, Audit Coordination Team (ACT), was in place and work on management's response to the Auditor General's recommendations was moving forward. The CAO will be reporting every two months to the Audit Committee and the October Update will provide more information.

9.1.2 Capital Cost Contribution Program

A staff report regarding the Capital Cost Contribution Program dated June 2, 2011 was before the Committee.

Mr. Peter Duncan, Manager, Infrastructure Planning, gave a brief overview of the June 2, 2011 report.

During discussion of the report, the Committee requested that staff provide a comparison of capital revenues realized through the proposed charges versus the existing charges. Note was made that the areas where CCCs would be utilized are identified in the Regional Plan as growth areas. The Committee further requested that staff utilize consistent data regarding population figures pointing to the Clerk's Office as having the most up to date information.

MOVED by Councillor Karsten, seconded by Councillor Mosher that the Audit and Finance Committee recommends Halifax Regional Council formally request the necessary amendments to the HRM Charter to allow Capital Cost Contributions to be collected from developers for the growth related portion of capital costs related to Fire Services, Recreation Facilities, Libraries and growth related studies. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

9.2 MEMBERS OF THE AUDT & FINANCE STANDING COMMITTEE

9.2.1 Councillor McCluskey – HRM Employee Reimbursement for Canada Games

An e-mail dated July 10, 2011 from Mr. Eric Cormier, Hacketts Cove, regarding reimbursement of employee vacation time for volunteering for the Canada Games.

This correspondence was forwarded to the CAO for response.

9.2.1 Councillor McCluskey – GHP/Destination Halifax/Trade Centre Ltd. Budget Presentations

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A brief discussion ensued as to whether the Greater Halifax Partnership, Destination Halifax and Trade Centre Limited would be required to present their budgets to this Committee. Note was made that there are potential cost savings between GHP and HRM (e.g. survey/research coordination) which should be considered.

MOVED by Councillor Karsten, seconded by Councillor Dalrymple that further consideration of this matter be deferred pending an update from the CAO as to whether these groups will be presenting their budgets to the Audit and Finance Standing Committee. MOTION PUT AND PASSED.

9.3 OFFICE OF THE AUDITOR GENERAL

9.3.1 District Activity and District Capital Funds

Mr. Larry Munroe, Auditor General, gave a brief presentation of his report relative to District Activity and District Capital Funds noting that the report was the result of a compliance review. A copy of the report entitled 'District Activity and District Capital Funds Compliance Review' as obtained from the Auditor General's web site http://halifax.ca/auditorgeneral/reports.html is included in the file for this meeting

Mr. Munroe responded to questions from members of the Committee. He noted that the recommendations addressed processes that could be improved. Mr. Munroe commented that as referred to in 2.2.2 in the Summary of Recommendations (Page 22 of the report), staff would be developing a request for funding form to be used when accessing these funds.

The Committee agreed that further discussion on this matter would be deferred to the next meeting of Audit and Finance Standing Committee in order to provide members an opportunity to review in detail the report.

9.3.2 Wireless Communications

Mr. Larry Munroe, Auditor General, gave a brief presentation of his report relative to Wireless Communications. A copy of the report entitled "Wireless Communications Review "as obtained from the Auditor General's web site http://halifax.ca/auditorgeneral/reports.html is included in the file for this meeting.

Mr. Munroe responded to questions from members of the Committee. He noted that staff has been working to update policies and negotiate contract extensions. Mr. Munroe indicated that staff's response to the recommendation has been positive and work is ongoing.
