## **ORIGIN**

This originates from a request from the Transportation Standing Committee for monthly status updates on the Commuter Rail project.

## **BACKGROUND**

Regional Council has directed staff to undertake a feasibility study for commuter rail in the Halifax – Windsor Junction – Enfield corridor. In order to complete this work the services of a consultant(s) with the relevant expertise and experience will be required.

## **STATUS**

CPCS Transcom has been selected to prepare the commuter rail feasibility study (RFP #14-047). CPCS Transcom is an international management consulting firm with extensive experience in rail feasibility studies and economic analysis, and were formerly the consulting arm of the Canadian Pacific Railway. Staff from Halifax Transit will be meeting with CPCS Transcom on September 9, 2014, to begin the study.
