Re: **Traffic Division Update – May 1-31, 2012**

Traffic monthly theme for April was "Bicycle and Motorcycle Safety".  
Our theme for the month of June will be "Speeding Enforcement".

SOTs issued for the month of May, 2012

During the month of May, Traffic officers continued to work with E-Ticketing in order to work the bugs out of the system. Also, the month of May saw a greater use of the police motorcycles thus the use of E-SOT was reduced as the bikes are yet to be equipped with computer capability. That is expected to be examined later this summer.

Between April 30 and May 4, a complete Police Motorcycle re-certification program was conducted at Shearwater runway. Two new members of the Integrated Traffic Team were trained in the safe use of the police motorcycles. A total of 12 Traffic members and 12 additional non-Traffic team officers were tested and passed the recertification requirements.

On May 8 and 9, the Traffic unit partnered with Service N.S. inspection officers in a joint traffic check point in an effort to reduce the number of un-roadworthy vehicles on the highways. During these check points, several hundred cars and trucks were checked and numerous SOTs issued for safety infractions. Onsite inspections were conducted and three cars were removed from the road due to standard failure.

On May 12 an officer from the Traffic Unit participated in a Police Week display at Micmac Mall with one of our new Victory police motorcycles which proved to be a big attraction to members of the public both young and old.

On May 26, six members of the Traffic team volunteered to participate in the annual biker blood donor clinic at the Bayer's Rd. Red Cross facility.
