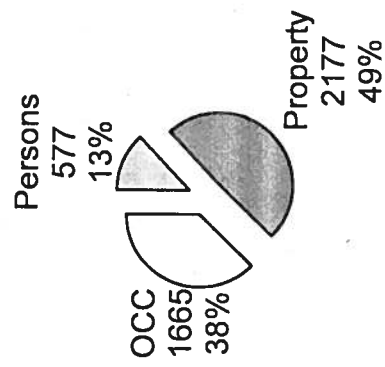
**Crimes Against Persons

2011-2012**

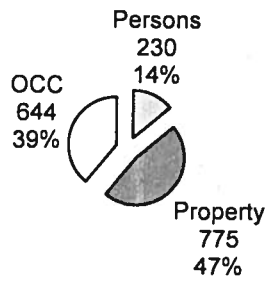


Halifax Regional Police 2nd Quarter Regional Stats 2012



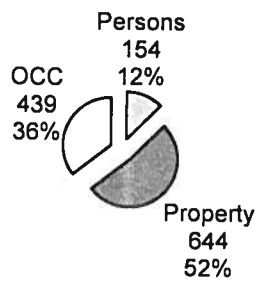

HRP 2nd Quarter Stats East



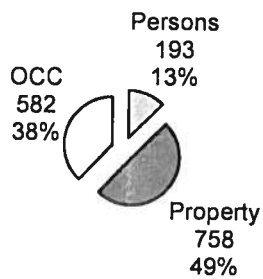

2nd Quarter 2012

Total City Wide Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the second quarter of 2012 show a decrease of -656 reported offences or a % of change = -13 % compared to the second quarter of 2011. Drugs for second quarter 2012 show a decrease of -19 offences or a % of change = -9.5 % compared to second quarter 2011.

Property offences account for 49% of reported C.C.C. offences, while crimes against persons account for 13% and other criminal code offences account for 38%.

Property Crimes

Property crime shows a decrease of -312 reported offences or -12.54% of change.

Stolen motor vehicles decreased by -46 offences or a % of change = -35.1%.

Break and Enters decreased by -55 offences or a % of change = -18.77%.

Fraud decreased by -18 offences or a % of change = -6.95%.

Violent Crimes

Violent crimes has experienced a decrease in the second quarter of 2012 compared to 2011 by -160 offences or a % of change = -21.7%.

Robberies decreased by -28 offences or a % of change = -31.82%.

Homicides have experienced an increase in the second quarter of 2012 by 1 incident or a % of change of +33.33% compared to the second quarter of 2011.

Attempt murders decreased by -2 offences, down from 7 in 2011 to 5 in the second quarter of 2012.

Assaults decreased in the second quarter of 2012 by 130 incidents with 498 reported. Assaults account for 86% of violent crimes in the second quarter of 2012.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc). Counterfeiting offences have decreased by 15 in the second quarter of 2012 over 2011, and wilful damage under \$5000 has decreased by 30 offences in 2012.

Prostitution offences decreased by -11 offences in the second quarter of 2012 over 2011.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

Fail to Appear and bail violations have increased by 11 offences in the second quarter of 2012.
