




#### 3rd Quarter 2014 Reported Crime Distribution by District




#### Crimes Against Persons 3rd Quarter Comparison 2013 - 2014








#### Crimes Against Property 3rd Quarter Comparison 2013 - 2014












# Assaults - Break & Enter - Theft Under July - September 2013/14

#### Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 69% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2014, the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2013 had a result of 66% and experienced a -4.42% **decrease** in 2014 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 10% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2014 compared to 15% in 2013 and experienced a -34.62 **decrease** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 14% of the total  $\underline{\text{Assaults}}$  in the  $3^{\text{rd}}$  quarter of 2014 compared to 11% in 2013.

#### Break & Enter

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 60% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2014 compared to 44% in 2013 and experienced a +36.59% *increase* in 2014 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 21% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in 2014 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter compared to 39% in 2013 and experienced a -45.95% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 17% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2014 compared to 17% in 2013 and experienced a -0% change in 2014 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle under \$5,000 accounted for 53% of the total <u>Theft Under \$5,000</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2014 compared to 51% in 2013 and experienced a -7.17% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods increased in the  $3^{rd}$  quarter of 2014 by +14 incidents when compared to the same period in 2013.

Theft of Bicycle experienced a +6.67% *increase* in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2014 over the same period last year.

Shoplifting Under \$5,000 decreased by 14 incidents in the  $3^{rd}$  quarter of 2014 when compared to the same period in 2013.

# HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan of Quarterly Crime Statistics 3rd Quarter 2014

#### **Total City Wide Criminal Code Offences/Drugs**

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the third quarter of 2014 show an increase of +338 reported offences or a change of +5.85% compared to the third quarter of 2013. Drugs for third quarter 2014 show an increase of +27 offences or a change of +8.67% compared to third quarter 2013.

Property offences accounted for 52% of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against persons account for 12% and other criminal code offences account for 36%.

#### **Violent Crimes**

Homicides were unchanged with 1 incident in 2014 and 1 incident in the third quarter of 2013.

Attempt murders increased by +3 offences in 2014 compared to the third quarter of 2013 or +30%.

Robberies decreased by -3 offences or -6%.

Assaults decreased by -1 offences or -.15%. Assaults account for 91% of violent crimes in the third quarter of 2014.

Violent crime experienced a decrease in the third quarter of 2014 over 2013 by -1 offence or -.14%.

#### **Property Crimes**

Break and Enters decreased by -91 offences or -21.7%.

Stolen motor vehicles decreased by -35 offences or -25%.

Theft over \$5,000 increased by +14 offences or +73.6%

Theft under \$5,000 decreased by -40 offences or -1.88%

Have Stolen Goods increased by +169 offences or +264%

Frauds increased by +69 offences or +21.9%.

Property crime shows an increase of +86 reported offences or +2.79%.

#### **Criminal Other**

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc) has increased by 253 or by +12.7%.

Prostitution offences increased by 6 offences in the third quarter of 2014 over 2013 or +66.6%. Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
