



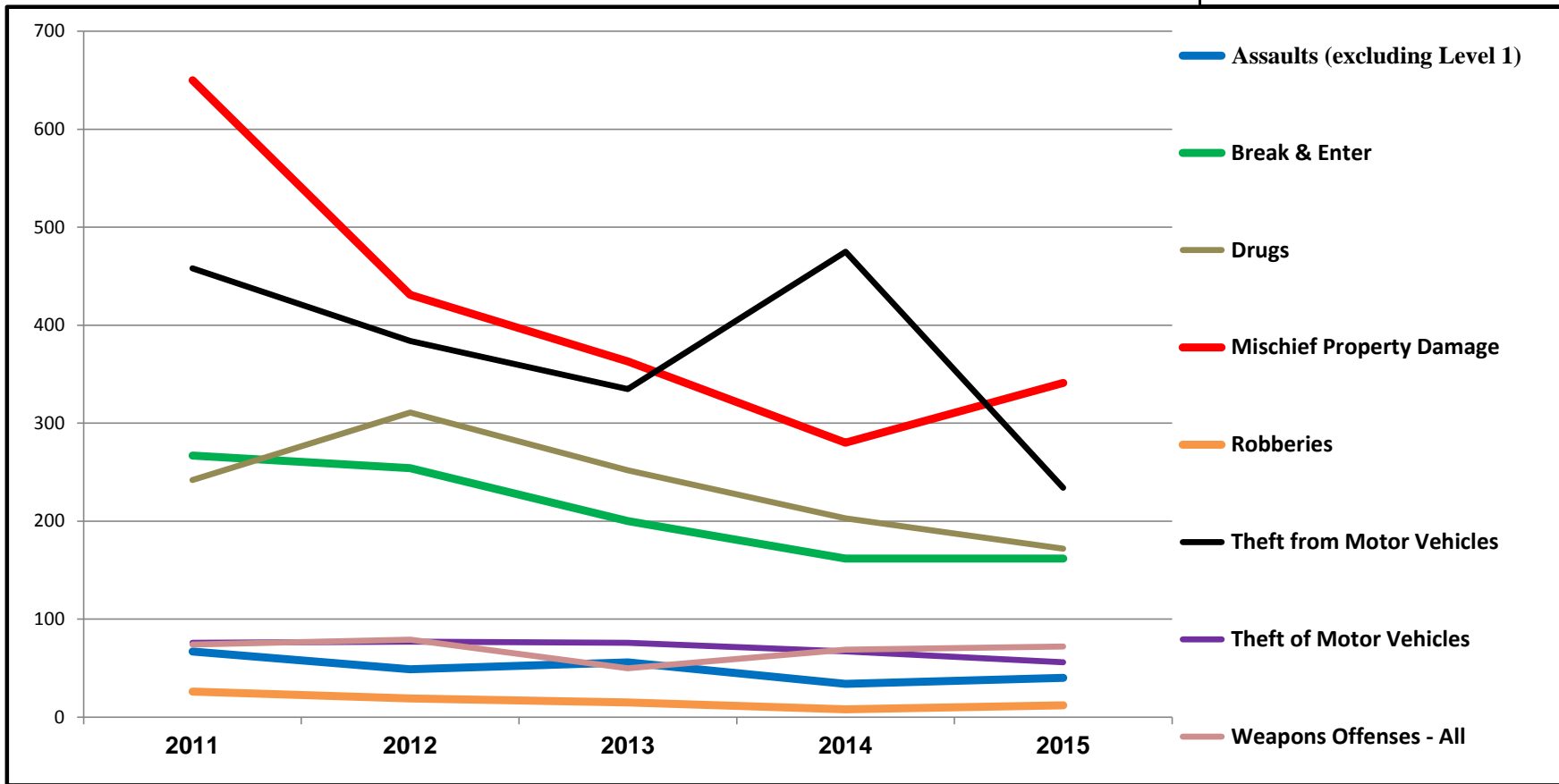

Halifax District continues to see double digit reduction Comstat numbers on it's targeted Crime types. From January to June 2015 the District has experienced a -16% overall decrease when compared to the same period last year. The Comstat model has contributed to a reduction in targeted crime for the 5th year in a row across the District.





## Youth Problem Oriented Policing - YPOP Summer 2015 Direction

Summer of 2015 takes our Community Policing and School Resource Officers back out on the streets for July and August. The role of the YPOP Program is to actively contribute to the Halifax District Crime Reduction Strategy through a number of initiatives throughout the summer months. The YPOP Officers will work as one team and will have the mobility to address a number of issues which arise during the summer season with the flexibility to move around and address issues throughout the District as a team. Prolific, Chronic and Social Offender's as well as Youth at Risk identified through the Com Stat process will be an integral part of the YPOP focus.



Analysis will be done as part of our existing strategy allowing YPOP to utilize real time data and provide a targeted focus for :

- Street Check Locations
- Checkpoint Locations
- Problem Youth Complaint locations – Hot Spot Mapping
- Hot spot patrols both - Foot Patrols and Bike Patrols
- Operation Breach , Conditional Sentence Order Checks
- Regular review of all youth complaints for inclusion in Hub program
- Beach, Park and Youth hang outs – Targeted enforcement at the right time in the right place
- Road Safety Initiative (Impaired & Distracted Drivers)
- Repeat Calls for Service – dealing with root cause to reduce calls for service where possible
- Special Events
- ATV Patrols
- Co-ordinating Operation Hawkeye for TFMV locations
- Assistance to District Sites
