Environmental Scan of 2015 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

<u>Total Criminal Code</u> offences in the third quarter of 2015 show a **decrease** of -203 or -13.29% compared to the third quarter in 2014.

<u>Drugs</u> for the third quarter of 2015 **decreased** by -24 or -19.51% compared to the third quarter of 2014.

In the third quarter <u>Property offences</u> count for 43% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against <u>Persons</u> account for 13% and <u>Criminal Other</u> offences account for 44%.

## Third Quarter comparison between 2014 and 2015:

#### **Property Crimes**

Overall Property Crime **decreased** by -197 or -25.68%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **increased** by +5 or +15.63%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -2 or -2.13%.

Fraud incidents **decreased** by -25 or -28.41%.

#### Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **increased** by +15 or +9.38%.

Robberies **increased** by +10 or +166.67%.

Homicides **increased** by +1 or +100%.

Attempted Murders **decreased** by -1 or -100%.

Assaults **increased** by +4 or +2.61%.

Assaults accounted for 90% of reported violent crimes in the third quarter of 2015.

## Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **decreased** by -16 in the third quarter of 2015 or by -38.10%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 0 in both the third quarter of 2014 and 2015.



Victim Services

October, 2015

The RCMP Victim Services program in Halifax District is overseen by a Coordinator and includes a roster of 12 volunteers. They follow up with victims of crime via telephone to offer support and referral services. The range of incidents they respond to is very broad and can include suicide, sudden death, assault, domestic violence, sexual assault, break & enter, etc.

## For the month of October:

- o The Victim Services Coordinator reviewed 252 files this month.
- Victim Services volunteers followed up on 19 files but had 43 victims to provide support. We had 3 Fatal MVA's
- o There were no file referred to the Department of Justice's Victim Services for follow up, as charges were laid.

























Environmental Scan of 2015 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

<u>Total Criminal Code</u> offences in the third quarter of 2015 show a **decrease** of -203 or -13.29% compared to the third quarter in 2014.

<u>Drugs</u> for the third quarter of 2015 **decreased** by -24 or -19.51% compared to the third quarter of 2014.

In the third quarter <u>Property offences</u> count for 43% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against <u>Persons</u> account for 13% and <u>Criminal Other</u> offences account for 44%.

## Third Quarter comparison between 2014 and 2015:

#### **Property Crimes**

Overall Property Crime **decreased** by -197 or -25.68%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **increased** by +5 or +15.63%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -2 or -2.13%.

Fraud incidents **decreased** by -25 or -28.41%.

#### Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime **increased** by +15 or +9.38%.

Robberies **increased** by +10 or +166.67%.

Homicides **increased** by +1 or +100%.

Attempted Murders **decreased** by -1 or -100%.

Assaults **increased** by +4 or +2.61%.

Assaults accounted for 90% of reported violent crimes in the third quarter of 2015.

## Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **decreased** by -16 in the third quarter of 2015 or by -38.10%.

Prostitution offences remained the same at 0 in both the third quarter of 2014 and 2015.



## Assaults - Break & Enter - Theft Under July - September 2014/15

#### **Assaults**

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 61% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2015, the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2014 had a result of 68% and experienced a -10% **decrease** in 2015 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 21% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2015 compared to 12% in 2014 and experienced a +46% **increase** over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 15% of the total <u>Assaults</u> in 2015 compared to 14% in 2014.

#### Robberies

Robberies accounted for 9% of the total <u>Persons Crime</u> in the 3rd quarter of 2015 compared to 4% in 2014 and experienced a +166.67% **increase** 2015 over the same period last year.

#### **Break & Enter**

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 47% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2015 compared to 60% in 2014 and experienced a **decrease** of -30%.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 37% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in 2015 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter compared to 21% in 2014 and experienced a +41% **increase** over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 14% of the total <u>Break & Enters</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2015 compared to 17% in 2014 and experienced a -23 **decrease** in 2015 over the same period last year.

## Theft Under \$5,000

Theft - Other Under \$5,000 accounted for 57% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2015 compared to 44% 2014, experiencing a -11% **decrease** in 2015 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle under \$5,000 accounted for 40% of the total <u>Theft Under \$5,000</u> in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2015 compared to 53% in 2014 and experienced a -49% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods experienced a -46% **decrease** in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2015 over the same period last year.

Theft of Bicycle experienced a -31% decrease in the  $3^{rd}$  quarter 2015 over the same period last year.

# HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan of Quarterly Crime Statistics 3rd Quarter 2015

#### **Total City Wide Criminal Code Offences/Drugs**

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the third quarter of 2015 shows a decrease of -570 reported offences or a change of -9.35% compared to the third quarter of 2014. Drugs for third quarter 2015 show a decrease of -48 offences or a change of -14.86% compared to third quarter 2014.

Property offences accounted for 49% of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against persons account for 14% and other criminal code offences account for 37%.

#### **Violent Crimes**

Homicides increased by 1 incident in 2015 with 3 in total compared to 2 in the third quarter of 2014.

Attempt murders decreased by -9 offences in 2015 compared to the third quarter of 2014 or -75%.

Robberies increased by +16 offences or +34.78%.

Assaults increased by +52 offences or +8.09%. Assaults account for 90% of violent crimes in the third quarter of 2015.

Violent crime experienced an increase in the third quarter of 2015 over 2014 by +64 offences or +9.04%.

#### **Property Crimes**

Break and Enters increased by +19 offences or 5.76%.

Stolen motor vehicles increased by +6 offences or 5.77%.

Theft over \$5,000 decreased by -4 offences or -13.79%

Theft under \$5,000 decreased by -241 offences or -11.63%

Have Stolen Goods decreased by -97 offences or -41.63%

Frauds decreased by -107 offences or -27.65%.

Property crime shows a decrease of -424 reported offences or -13.43%.

#### **Criminal Other**

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc) has decreased by -210 or by -9.40%.

Prostitution offences decreased by -7 offences in the third quarter of 2015 over 2014 or -46.67%. Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
