 Our theme for the month of July will be "Speeding" as well as "Distracted Driving".

SOTs issued for the month of June, 2012:

During the month of June, more than **570 speeding related tickets** were issued by the Traffic Unit in support of our monthly theme.

Also during the month of June, Traffic officers participated in several events.

On June 2, nine HRP riders attended the Town of Kentville at the invitation of Chief of Police Mander to assist with their annual Apple Blossom Parade.

On June 4, the Traffic team assisted with a joint forces project at Rainbow Gate of the Navy dockyards in co-operation with Military Police, Public Safety Division of Dept. of Justice NS and Service Nova Scotia Inspectors. The goal of the project was to inspect all vehicles accessing DND property. Eleven commercial vehicle were directed for immediate inspection. Four were removed from the roadway for infractions and three were re-inspected and repaired on site and then passed. Six non-commercial vehicles were re-directed for inspection and three of them were towed away for numerous roadworthy violations. Two military vehicles were inspected and rejected.

On June 20, the Traffic team connected with one of our community partners, IWK Child Safety Link, in order to do a public awareness child car seat campaign. More than 30 vehicles with various seat security issues were inspected by the IWK technicians and in one case a taxi transporting a mother with a two year old child in the back seat, was given a brand new car seat.
