## HRM Policing Services Environmental Scan 3rd Quarter 2016



### Total HRM Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the third quarter of 2016 show a **decrease** of **-199** reported offences or **-3.6%** compared to the third quarter of 2015. Drugs for third quarter 2016 show a **decrease** of **-13** offences or **-4.73%** compared to third quarter 2015.

Property offences account for **50%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for **13%** and Criminal Other offences account for **37%**.

### Property Crimes

Property crime shows a **decrease** of **-74** reported offences or **-2.72%**.

Stolen motor vehicles **decreased** by **-7** offences or **-6.54%**.

Break and Enters **decreased** by **-76** offences or **-21.9%**.

Frauds **increased** by **+10** offences or **+3.57%**.

### Violent Crimes

Violent crime has experienced a **decrease** in the third quarter of 2016 compared to 2015 by **-36** offences or a change of **-4.78%**.

Robberies **decreased** by **-6** offences or a change of **-9.52%**.

Homicides **decreased** by **-2** incidents in 2016 compared to the third quarter of 2015 or **-50%**.

Attempted murders remained unchanged reporting three in the third quarter of 2015 and 2016.

Assaults **decreased** by **-30** offences or a change of **-4.45%**. Assaults accounted for **90%** of violent crimes in the third quarter of 2016.

### Criminal Other

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc.) has **decreased** by **-88** or **-4.34%**.

Prostitution offences **decreased** by **-8** offences in the third quarter of **2016** over **2015** or **-88.8%**.

Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.

***Total City Wide Criminal Code Offences/Drugs***

*Total Criminal Code offences reported in the third quarter of 2016 show a decrease of -132 reported offences or a change of -3.15 % compared to the third quarter of 2015. Drugs for third quarter 2016 show an increase of +8 offences or a change of +4.57 % compared to third quarter 2015.*

*Property offences account for 50% of reported Criminal Code offences, while crimes against persons account for 14% and other criminal code offences account for 36%.*

***Property Crimes***

*Property crime decrease by -143 offences or -6.62%.*

*Stolen motor vehicles decreased by -20 offences or -27.78%.*

*Break and Enters decreased by -65 offences or -25.39%.*

*Fraud showed no change with 218 offences in both the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2015 and 2016.*

***Violent Crimes***

*Violent crimes has experienced a decrease in the third quarter of 2016 compared to 2015 by -7 offences or -1.21%.*

*Robberies increased by +6 offence or +12.77%.*

*Homicides decreased by -2offence, reporting 1 incident in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2016 compared to 3 incidents in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2015.*

*Attempt murders decreased by -1 offence, down from 3 in third quarter of 2015 to 2 in third quarter of 2016.*

*Assaults decreased in the third quarter of 2016 by -11 incidents with 507 reported. Assaults account for 88% of violent crimes in the third quarter of 2016.*

***Other Criminal Code***

*OCC includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc). Counterfeiting offences have decreased by -1 in the third quarter of 2016 over 2015, and wilful damage under \$5000 has increased by +44 offences in 2016.*

*Prostitution offences decreased by -8 offences in the third quarter of 2016 over 2015.*

*Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.*

*Fail to Appear and bail violations have increased by +54 offences in the third quarter of 2016.*
