Environmental Scan of 2013 2nd Quarter

Total District Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences in the second quarter of 2013 show a **decrease** of -98 or -6.08% compared to the second quarter in 2012.

Drugs for the second quarter of 2013 **decreased** by -16 or -10.53% compared to the second quarter of 2012.

In the second quarter Property offences count for 52% of Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against Persons account for 12% and Other Criminal Code offences account for 35%.

Second Quarter comparison between 2012 and 2013:

Property Crimes

Overall Property Crime **decreased** by -98 or -11.01%.

Stolen Motor Vehicles **decreased** by -3 or -6.67%.

Break and Enters **decreased** by -15 or -10.87%.

Fraud incidents *increased* by 27 or 36.99%.

Violent Crimes

Overall Violent Crime *increased* by 16 or 9.36%.

Robberies **decreased** by -2 or -28.57%.

Homicides **decreased** by -1 or -100%.

Attempted Murders *increased* by 3 or 300%.

Assaults increased by 9 or 5.59%.

Assaults accounted for 91% of reported violent crimes in the second quarter of 2013.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (i.e. arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting currency etc.)

Offensive Weapons **decreased** by -2 in the second quarter of 2013 or by -5.71%.

Prostitution offences *increased* by 4 in the second quarter of 2013 or by 100%.



**Crimes Against Persons

2012-2013**




**Crimes Against Property

2012-2013**






RCMP Halifax District 2nd Quarter Stats Cole Harbour



RCMP Halifax District 2nd Quarter Stats Lower Sackville




RCMP Halifax District 2nd Quarter Stats Musquodoboit Harbour





Assaults

Assaults Level 1 accounted for 57% of the total Assaults in the 2nd quarter of 2013, the 2nd quarter of 2012 had a result of 64% and experienced a -2% **decrease** in 2013 over the same period last year.

Assault with a Weapon Causing Bodily Harm accounted for 15% of the total Assaults in 2013 compared to 12% in 2012 and experienced a 42% *increase* over the same period last year.

All forms of Sexual Assaults combined accounted for 19% of the total Assaults in 2013 compared to 16% in 2012.

Robberies accounted for 3% of the total Persons Crime in the 2nd quarter of 2013 compared to 4% in 2012 and experienced a -29% **decrease** in 2013 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Residence) accounted for 50% of the total Break & Enters in the 2nd quarter of 2013 compared to 44% in 2012 and experienced a 3% *increase* in 2013 over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Other) accounted for 30% of the total Break & Enters in 2013 2nd quarter compared to 23% in 2012 and experienced a 16% *increase* over the same period last year.

Break & Enter (Business) accounted for 17% of the total Break & Enters in the 2nd quarter 2013 compared to 30% in 2012 and experienced a -49% **decrease** in 2013 over the same period last year.

Theft - Other Under \$5,000 accounted for 53% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 2nd quarter of both 2013 and 2012, experiencing a -15% **decrease** in 2013 over the same period last year.

Theft from Motor Vehicle under \$5,000 accounted for 41% of the total Theft Under \$5,000 in the 2nd quarter 2013 compared to 40% in 2012 and experienced a -13% **decrease** over the same period last year.

Possession of Stolen Goods experienced a -31% **decrease** in the 2nd quarter 2013 over the same period last year.

Theft of Bicycle experienced a -23% **decrease** in the 2nd quarter 2013 over the same period last year.

Shoplifting Under \$5,000 experienced a -45% **decrease** in the 2nd quarter 2013 over the same period last year.

Total City Wide Criminal Code Offences/Drugs

Total Criminal Code offences reported in the second quarter of 2013 show a decrease of -562 reported offences or a % change of -9.32 compared to the second quarter of 2012. Drugs for second quarter 2013 show a decrease of -22 offences or a % change of -6.61 compared to second quarter 2012.

Property offences accounted for **50%** of the reported Total Criminal Code offences, while crimes against persons account for **14%** and other criminal code offences account for **36%**.

Violent Crimes

Homicides decreased by -4 incidents in 2013 compared to the second quarter of 2012 or -80% .

Attempt murders increased by +4 offences in 2013 compared to the second quarter of 2012 or +57.14%.

Robberies decreased by -9 offences or -13.64%.

Assaults increased by +25 offences or +3.82%. Assaults account for 89% of violent crimes in the second quarter of 2013.

Violent crime experienced an increase in the second quarter of 2013 over 2012 by +17 offences or +2.28%.

Property Crimes

Break and Enters decreased by -43 offences or -11.41%.

Stolen motor vehicles decreased by -24 offences or -18.46%.

Theft over \$5,000 decreased by -1 offence or -2.94%

Theft under \$5,000 decreased by -343 offences or -15.74%

Have Stolen Goods decreased by -35 offences or -33.98%

Frauds increased by +72 offences or +22.78%.

Property crime shows a decrease of -374 reported offences or -11.91%.

Other Criminal Code

Includes prostitution, gaming/betting, offensive weapons, and other criminal code offences (arson, property damage, indecent acts, counterfeiting, etc) has decreased by -215 or by -10.50% .

Prostitution offences increased by +14 offences in the second quarter of 2013 over 2012 or +350%. Please note offences such as drug and prostitution are sensitive to directed enforcement and detection.
