- it was noted an underground system would be permitted
- HRM has stormwater easement under the CN rail way tracks
- the parking lot will be located two hundred feet from the watercourse
- roof water will be controlled through the storm water system

- 3. Permission to dump the water onto the Waterfront Development Corporation lands.
- 4. It contributes to the Community Visioning plan and is esthetically pleasing.
- 5. Information from Developer advising what will be done with the open water in the gully on the property.
- 6. Information be provided regarding flow requirements.
