#### 6. REPORTS

#### 6.1 Draft Consolidated Mobile Home Park Bylaw

Ms. Leticia Smillie, Planner 1 and Ms. Randa Wheaton, Senior Planner, gave an overview of the draft consolidated By-law that was before the Committee. They advised that some sections had been removed, some had been modified and that additions had been made to produce the By-law before the Committee. Ms. Smillie noted the first page of the draft By-Law included an explanation of the purpose of the changes and instructions on how to read the By-law.

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Discussion ensued with note being made that work on the draft by-law is ongoing. The By-law will be brought back to the next meeting.

### 7. ADDED ITEMS

## 7.1 Rights of Mobile Home park Owners and Their Tenants

Councillor Hendsbee asked staff to look into what rights Mobile Home Park owners have to protect their property and that of their tenants from vandalism and harm; and, what rights does the tenant, as an individual have to protect their property from vandalism and harm. Can a curfew be imposed or is this infringing on the rights of the individual.

The Committee asked that staff be invited to a future meeting to speak to Information Items 1 & 2. Staff was also requested to present the December 2007 reports Mobile Home Parks - Street Lighting Policy and Mobile Home Taxes and Liens at a future meeting.
