#### INFORMATION REPORT

### **ORIGIN**

On January 23, 2007 a petition was presented to Harbour East Community Council by the residents and owners of the Canal Bridge Condominium which outlines their displeasure about a sign at 167 Portland Street.

### BACKGROUND/ DISCUSSION

On July 11, 2000 Regional Council adopted the Downtown Dartmouth Land Use By-Law. This by-law includes signage provisions which prohibit back lit signs. Any sign that existed prior to adoption of the by-law is grand fathered and permitted under the nonconforming provisions of the Municipal Government Act.

Records indicate that the original sign permit was issued in 1983 and the current business was located within the building in 1992. These permits pre-date the current requirements under the Downtown Dartmouth Land Use-By-Law. Therefore the sign was permitted under the regulations of the day and is not a violation of the current land use by-law requirements.
