#### **ORIGIN**

Motion of Harbour East Community Council at their meeting of November 03, 2005 that staff initiate the process to rezone the HRM parcel of land near the Dartmouth sewage treatment plant (formerly provincial land between the North Woodside Community Centre and the Reigh Allen Centre) from the Institutional Zone to P (Park).
