ORIGIN

North West Planning Advisory Committee meeting - November 7, 2007

RECOMMENDATION

The North West Planning Advisory Committee recommend that North West Community Council:

- 1. **Recommend that Regional Council** give First Reading to the proposed amendments to the Bedford MPS and LUB as provided in Attachments A and B of the staff report dated October 24, 2007, with amendments to add policy that would permit all units within this development to be constructed prior to the interchange, and schedule a joint public hearing with North West Community Council;
- 2. **Recommend that Regional Council** approve the proposed amendments to the Bedford MPS and LUB as provided in Attachments A and B of the staff report dated October 24, 2007, as amended above; and
- 3. **Move Notice of Motion** to consider the proposed development agreement and discharging agreement as provided in Attachments C and D, with amendments to Section 3.4 of the development agreement (Attachment C) that would permit all units within this development to be constructed prior to the interchange, and to require three oil and grit seperators, and schedule a joint public hearing with Regional Council.

Contingent upon the adoption by Regional Council of the above Municipal Planning Strategy and Land Use By-law amendments and those becoming effective under the *Municipal Government Act*, it is further recommended that North West Community Council:

1. Approve the proposed development agreement and discharging agreement as provided in Attachments C and D, with amendments to Section 3.4 of the development agreement (Attachment C) that would permit all units within this development to be constructed prior to the interchange, and to require three oil and grit seperators; and

2. Require the development agreements be signed within 120 days, or any extension thereof granted by North West Community Council on request of the applicant, from the date of final approval of said agreements by North West Community Council and any other bodies as necessary, whichever is later, including applicable appeal periods. Otherwise this approval shall be void and any obligations arising hereunder shall be at an end.
