DISCUSSION

At its October 10, 2007 meeting, The North West Transit Advisory Committee passed a motion requesting that North West Community Council request Metro Transit remove the #84 and #85 service at the bus stop Barrington Street near side Artz Street North Bound at the start of the ramp to the MacDonald Bridge.

At this meeting, the committee received correspondence from a resident, Mr. Robert Wilde, indicating that this bus stop delays the Routes 84 and 85. If there is a traffic jam due to construction work, vehicle breakdowns or accidents on the MacDonald Bridge, all routes at the stop are delayed. Metro Transit staff were in attendance and informed the Committee of the difficulties of removing the route from the bus stop.
