RECOMMENDATION

The Bedford Watershed Advisory Board, upon review of the Bedford West Stormwater Management Plan for West Bedford Holdings Limited regarding Sub-areas 3, 4, and 6 as presented in December 2007 document prepared by Jacques Whitford NAWE, Inc. recommends North West Community Council approve the Plan subject to the following conditions:

- a. Due to BWAB's concern about the CDS unit's ability to accomplish its function in regard to phosphorus removal, that Community Council and staff take note of its implementation.
- b. The Developer prepare a Best Practices Guide for the homeowner's use.
- c. Results of the water quality tests be provided to BWAB.
- d. The Development Agreement include an enforcement clause that will ensure compliance, (i.e. similar to what was put in the Morris Lake Development Agreement).
