RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Regional Council authorize the award of Tender #04-053 to Atlantic Air Cleaning Specialists Ltd. at a cost of \$59,174.52 (net HST incl) with funding from Capital Account No. CBF00444, Station Replacement, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Halifax Regional Municipality publicly advertised tenders for a Vehicle Exhaust Extraction System for the new Highfield Fire Station.

DISCUSSION

Atlantic Air Cleaning Specialists Ltd. will be supplying and installing a Plymovent Model STRA-85 emergency vehicle exhaust system capable of accommodating six(6) vehicles at the new Highfield Fire Station.

Installation is scheduled for end of May.

BUDGET IMPLICATIONS

Funding for this project in the amount of \$59,174.52 (Net HST incl) is available in Capital account No. CBF00444, Station Replacement. This has been confirmed by Financial Services.

Unspent Budget \$486,457.00 Less: Tender 03-149 \$59,174.52 \$427,283.47

The net HST has been included in the award amount. The Federal Government, in the recent speech from the throne, has proposed changes that would provide a GST rebate to Municipalities. This legislation, once approved, will affect the total cost of this award. Once the legislation is in place, and the actual amount determined, the value will be adjusted accordingly.
