SUBJECT:	Sole Source Purchase of Bomb Suits, Helmets and Accessories.	

ORIGIN

Approved 2003/04 Capital Budget. Additional bomb suits, helmets and accessories for the CBRN response unit involves a sole source vendor, which necessitates Council approval.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that Regional Council authorize the purchase of additional bomb suits, helmets and accessories from the equipment manufacturer, Med-Eng Systems Inc. at a cost of \$53,022.60 plus net HST for a total project cost of \$54,840.75 with funding from Capital Account No. CEK00338, Bio-Hazard Equipment, as outlined in the Budget Implications section of this report.

BACKGROUND

The Halifax Regional Municipality requested a quotation from Med-Eng Systems Inc. for additional Bomb Suits, helmets and accessories for the Halifax Regional Police Service.

The total cost of the equipment is as follows:

DISCUSSION

The Halifax Regional Police Service, in conjunction with the Halifax Regional Fire and Emergency Service, is requesting Council approval to purchase the necessary equipment for a chemical, biological, radiological and nuclear(CBRN) response. Many CBRN incidents utilize an explosive device as a means to accelerate contamination. This equipment will allow Halifax Regional Police to provide the upmost in response to a CBRN incident which involves an explosive device while offering the CBRN team and responding Explosive Device Unit(EDU) members the maximum in protection and detection available. The equipment supplied by Med-Eng Systems Inc. is compatible with existing HRP bio-hazard equipment. Delivery is scheduled for August 11th, 2004.

This equipment is being purchased under the "sole source purchase section 7.8.1" of the Procurement Policy which states:

"Where the compatibility of a purchase with existing equipment, facilities or service is a paramount consideration and the purchase must be made from a single source."
