

SUBJECT: Request - Military Flyby

INFORMATION REPORT

ORIGIN

Letter dated July 16, 2004, from John Knudsen, Parade Coordinator, Air Force Association of Canada advising of military flyby.

BACKGROUND

The Department of National Defence have recently changed the requirements for military flyby to require written permission from the municipality if a flyby is to take place over any part of a city or town.

DISCUSSION

HRM has been advised that two military flyby, consisting of Canadian Forces Sea King helicopters, will take place in the Halifax Regional Municipality. One as part of the annual Battle of Britain Memorial Service Parade and Ceremony to be held Sunday, September 19, 2004, at 2:00 p.m. in the vicinity of Sullivan's Pond, Dartmouth and the second as part of the Annual General Meeting of the Air Force Association of Canada to be held Saturday, October 9, 2004, at 11:00 a.m. over Grand Parade, downtown Halifax.

Halifax Regional Municipality has a strong connection with its military and these events serve to honour and recognize the efforts of our military personnel.


HRM could choose not support the request for the military flyby to take place within its boundaries.

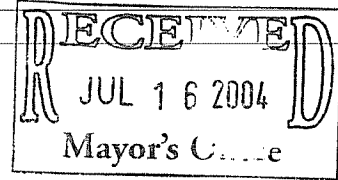

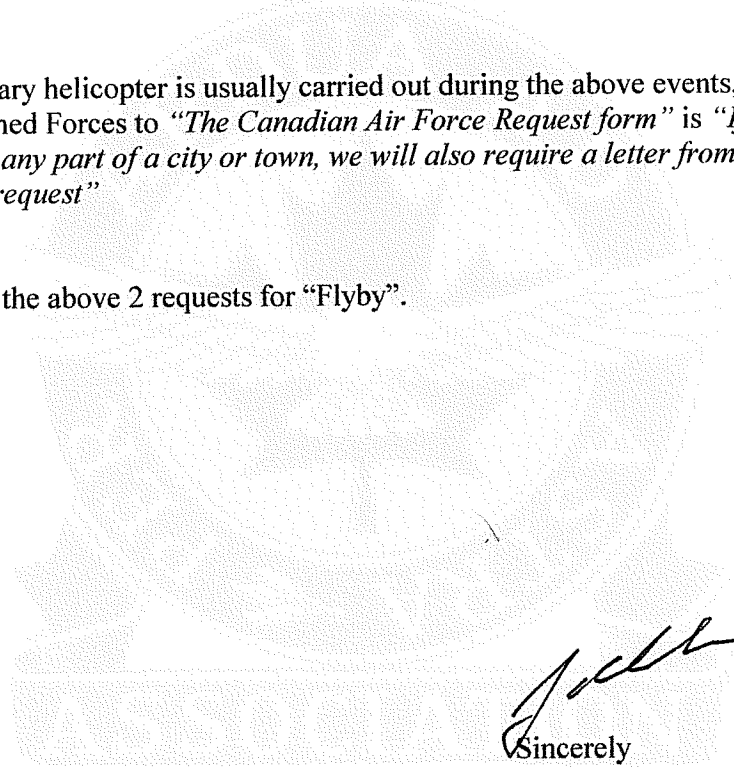
