ORIGIN

May 18, 2004, Regional Council - Petition in support of a boat launch on the Upper Lakeville Road.

DISCUSSION

At the May 18, 2004, Regional Council, Deputy Mayor Streatch presented a petition in support of a boat launch on the Upper Lakeville Road. Staff has met with the local MLA, Councillor and community representatives to assess and determine the needs of the community. It has been proposed that HRM would purchase the land at far market value and that the local MLA would fund the development of the site.

The proposed site which was originally identified on Upper Lakeville Road was determined not suitable for a boat launch. Therefore, staff is presently working with the MLA, Councillor and community representative to locate a suitable site. When a site has been identified staff will prepare a report for council's approval.
